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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The quality and results of the Centres of Innovative Educational Technologies have been evaluated on the basis of the data of teacher surveys that have been conducted in three of Kazakhstan's higher education universities that are partners in the project.

The assessment of the Centres of Innovative Educational Technologies is based on the opinions of the survey participants. The purpose of this evaluation is to determine the degree of compliance of the CIEs with the innovative work with students and staff in the field of new educational technologies. This evaluation report will be attached to the progress reports.

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this study was to determine the quality of the IET Centres. The evaluation methodology consisted of collecting feedback from participants of online courses on digital skills acquisition in the field of innovative teaching and learning about the IET Centre, their analysis and conclusions about the results.

The Centres for Innovative Educational Technology were created to organise work in partner universities to modernise learning through the introduction of new digital learning technologies and didactic models. The objectives of the Centres are: implementation of innovative educational technologies in the partner universities; participation in the creation of interactive classes; training and provision of information, technical and methodological support for teachers to develop digital learning resources and web courses; creation and maintenance of the platform for IEOC virtual library; systematization of innovative teaching experience, development of new approaches in the implementation of the objectives of the educational theory and practice taking into account trends in the development of educational institutions and teaching technologies. Since the Centres have been operating, at least 380 teachers have been trained, 3 interactive classes have been equipped in each higher education institution, web-courses are being developed and placed on the virtual library platform.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The main goal of this project is adapting educational system in the partner countries to the digital generation using implementation and efficient use of innovative educational technologies and didactic models approach based on ICT in the educational process.

The Consortium consists of 24 full-fledged partners - Universities from 4 EU countries and 5 partner countries. The project will help transform higher education institutions into innovational Universities and enhance the quality of trained professionals needed for digital transformation of industries (Industry 4.0).





Centres of Innovative Educational Technologies were established in accordance with the project "Modernization of Higher Education in Central Asia through New Technologies" (HiEdTec), WP5.4.Report on the assessment results of Centres of Innovative Educational Technologies.



1. Which country are you from?



All 395 respondents represented Kazakhstan.


2. Which Center are you evaluating?

- 1 means that it was not structured, 5 means that it is very well- structured






Out of 382 responses, 321 respondents consider the quality of the centers to be excellent, 53 respondents – good, and 8 respondents-average.






5.3. It is clear for what the Center is needed









5.7. The technical instruments are being used in the institution




5.8. The use of technical equipment can be explained to the users





5.9. The equipment provided is exactly what was needed in the Institution to advance the learning processes






5.11. The Center is positioned well inside the institution








Summing up this group of questions, we can conclude that the vast majority of respondents gave high and very high ratings on all items, 9 -11 people were unwilling or unable to answer some questions, and 16 (4.2%) people expressed their dissatisfaction. The latter fact shows that there is room for improvement in the work of IET Centre. The question about the purpose of the equipment is the main source of difficulty for the respondents. Unfortunately, the questionnaire does not specify what equipment is meant in the question, which may have caused difficulty in answering this question.













6.4. The Center will help teachers to create innovative teaching inside the institution






6.6. The Center helps me to please the needs of my students better



6.8. The Center makes my life as a teacher easier








6.9. The Center makes teaching more fun






The bulk of answers agree or give a positive assessment of the courses:

9. Was the Centre established in time?


From the 380 respondents, 99.7% chose "yes".

CONCLUSION

Our chosen methodology for evaluating the quality of work and learning outcomes in the form of an anonymous questionnaire allows us to get objective feedback, on the basis of which we can develop recommendations for the further work of the IET Centres. A sample of 395 respondents, including almost all listeners, indicates the reliability of the results obtained.

Based on the analysis of the responses received, the following conclusions are made:

- All respondents that participated in the survey are well-aware of goals and objectives of Centres of Innovative Educational Technologies in partner countries' Universities
- The staff of the Centres are properly selected, competent, and always provide qualified assistance to teachers.
- The Centres were opened in due time, which contributed to improving the quality of teaching and the interest of students with the use of modern digital educational technologies, especially remote ones, during the quarantine in 2020 and 2021.
- The Centres contributed to the acquisition of the necessary competencies in the field of digital technologies by teachers.
- Teachers and students use and are ready to improve their skills in the use of modern digital educational technologies.
- The vast majority of respondents are satisfied with the work of the IET Centres.
