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### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Report on the Questionnaire for the evaluation of the courses for lecturers for the acquisition of digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods is prepared in accordance with the training courses which were conducted in Partner HEIs from Tajikistan.

Evaluation of the courses for lecturers for the acquisition of digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods will be performed. The quality and benefits of the trainings for the acquisition of digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods was evaluated considering the specific conditions in Tajikistan.

An Evaluation of the institutional courses for the acquisition of digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods will reflect the opinions of the participants. The aim of this evaluation is to determine whether the courses for lecturers for the acquisition of digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods were duly conducted in accordance with the requirements. This evaluation report will be annexed to the progress reports.

The courses for lecturers for the acquisition of digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods were organized in accordance with the project of Modernization of Higher Education System in Central Asia through new technologies (HiEdTec), WP5.8.





### **INTRODUCTION**

The purpose of evaluation was to collect feedback about the institutional courses for the acquisition of digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods. The training courses were organized be the trainers to the lecturers of Khorog State University named after M. Nazarshoev (P8), Tajik Technical University named after academician M. Osimi (P9), Technological University of Tajikistan (P10). Institutional courses or trainings of lecturers were aimed at creating digital skills and innovative methods of teaching and learning, and also consisted of teaching lecturers to use a learning management system, such as Moodle, in the educational process and introduce useful functions of this system in the classroom.

Courses for lecturers for the acquisition of digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods were attended by Tajikistan partners, and in the process of their conduct, lecturers acquired skills to improve their teaching methods, and they recognize that these trainings were really fruitful and useful to them. Courses for lecturers for the acquisition of digital skills and learning methods were attended at least by 50 lecturers/teachers from each Partner institution from Tajikistan (total 155). Furthermore, the courses assisted in raising awareness of the need to adapt the education system to the digital generation in the institutions.





### **PROJECT OVERVIEW**

Trainers trained in digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods organized courses for lecturers in each Partner HEI in Tajikistan. The courses were practice-oriented and allowed lecturers/teachers to further use them in the educational process.

The main goal of the project is to adapt the education system in the partner countries to the digital generation by introducing and effectively using innovative educational technologies and didactic models (IET & DM) based on ICT in the educational process.

The consortium consists of 24 full partners - universities from 4 EU countries and 5 PCs. The project will help transform partner higher education institutions into innovative universities and improve the quality of trained specialists needed to carry out the digital transformation of industries (Industry 4.0).

The Project acknowledges the use of technology in transforming learning, developing collaboration solutions, enhancing the role of educators in innovative technology-supported learning environments allowing them to be engaged in professional learning experiences that will prepare to adeptly apply research-based approaches to didactic teaching.




### 1. Which country are you from? 155 responses

From 155 answers 76.8% of the responders find the structure of training courses extremely well-structured, 22,6% as well structured and 0.6% structured.









3. Please tell us how you rate the quality using a 1 to 5 scale where 1 means very bad and 5 means extremely good.


### 8. Were the trainig courses given on time? 155 responses
