The report on the Questionnaire for the Assessment of Open Educational Resources in Kyrgyzstan was prepared in accordance with the training courses that were conducted in partner universities from Kyrgyzstan.

This will be an assessment of open educational resources in Kyrgyzstan. The quality and possibilities of using open educational resources in Kyrgyzstan were assessed taking into account the specific conditions in Kyrgyzstan.

The evaluation of open educational resources in Kyrgyzstan will reflect the opinions of the participants. The purpose of this assessment is to determine whether open educational resources in Kyrgyzstan have been properly created in accordance with the requirements. This evaluation report will be attached to the progress reports.

Open Educational Resources in Kyrgyzstan was organized in accordance with the project "Modernization of the system of higher education in Central Asia with the help of new technologies" (HiEdTec), WP4.4.

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the evaluation was to collect feedback on open educational resources in Kyrgyzstan. A virtual library of Kyrgyzstan has been created with digital educational resources based on the distance learning environment Moodle LMS. Library address: <https://open.kstu.kg/>

5 web-based courses were created by teachers of Ala-Too International University (P5), Issyk-Kul State University named after K. Tynystanov (P6), Kyrgyz State Technical University named after I. Razzakov (P7).

Within the framework of the HiEdTec project, communication equipment was supplied to the universities of the consortium of the Kyrgyz Republic, on the basis of which a virtual library of Kyrgyzstan was created, which hosts 15 web-based courses. Open educational resources in Kyrgyzstan were created in accordance with the project "Modernization of Higher Education in Central Asia through New Technologies" (HiEdTec) with the aim of improving the qualifications of teachers, teaching digital skills, adapting the educational system to the digital generation through

active and effective use based on ICT innovative educational technologies, thereby contributing to the digital transformation of education.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Trainers trained in digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods have organized teacher training courses at every partner university in Kyrgyzstan. The courses were focused on a practical orientation and allowed lecturers / teachers to further use them in the educational process.

The main goal of the project is to adapt the education system in partner countries to the digital generation by introducing and effectively using innovative educational technologies and didactic models based on ICT in the educational process.

The consortium consists of 24 full partners - universities from 4 EU countries and 5 PS. The project will help transform partner universities into innovative universities and improve the quality of trained specialists required for digital transformation of industries (Industry 4.0).

The project recognizes the use of technology in transforming learning, developing collaboration solutions, enhancing the role of educators in an innovative technology-supported learning environment, enabling them to engage in professional learning that prepares them to skillfully apply research-based approaches to didactic learning.

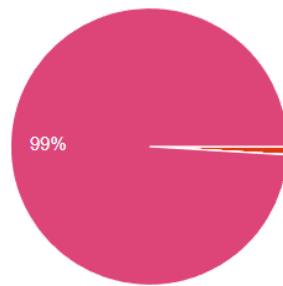
We received a total of 105 responses to our questionnaire:

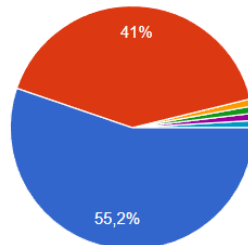

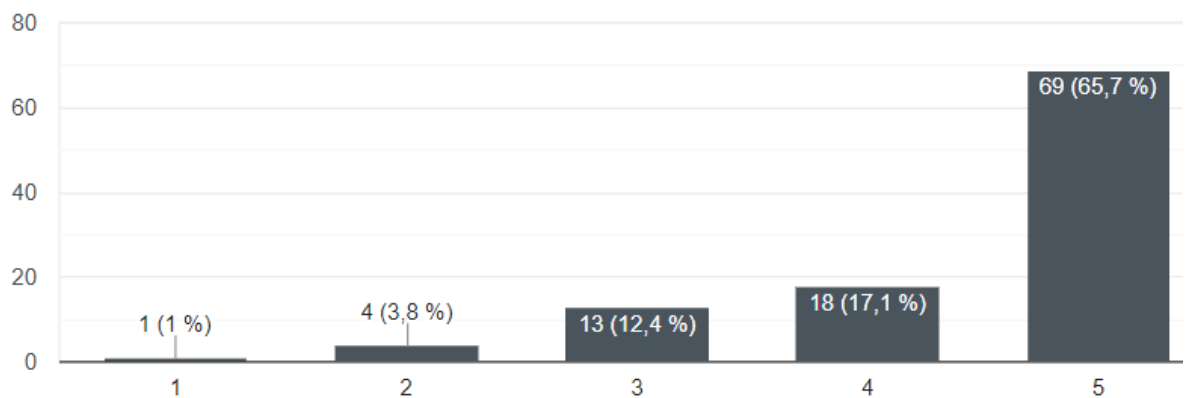

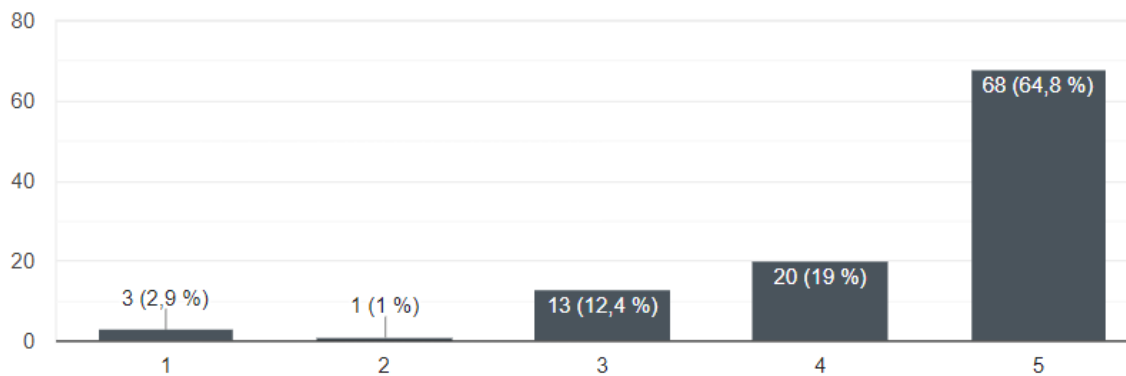

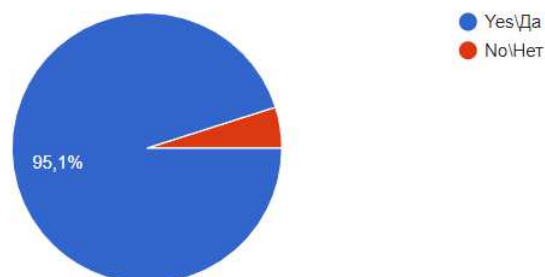

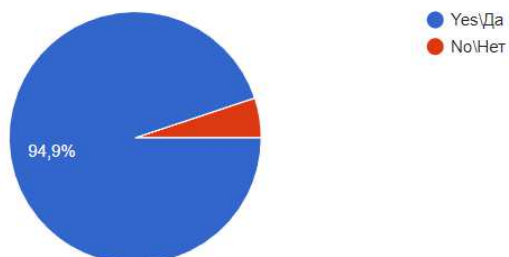




10. Did you get the chance for comments and criticism?
