The purpose of this assessment is to determine if the Centers for Innovation Educational Technology have been properly established in accordance with the requirements. This evaluation report will be attached to the records of the work done.

Centers for Innovative Educational Technologies were organized in accordance with the project "Modernization of the Higher Education System in Central Asia though new technologies" (HiEdTech), WP5.4.

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of evaluation was to collect feedback on the Centers for innovative educational technologies in Kyrgyzstan. Centers for innovative educational technologies were opened at the Ala-Too International University (P5), at the Issyk-Kul State University named after I. Tynystanov (P6), at the Kyrgyz State Technical University named after I. Razzakov (P7).

The centers were created in accordance with the project "Modernization of Higher Education in Central Asia through New Technologies" (HiEdTec) with the aim of improving the qualifications of teachers, teaching digital skills, adapting the educational system to the digital generation through the active and effective use of ICT-based innovative educational technologies thereby contributing to the digital transformation of education.

Objectives of the Center:

- assimilate innovative educational technologies, adapting them to the conditions of the university;
- promote innovative educational technologies, including virtual education model through various lectures, courses, seminars, etc.;
- assist in equipping all lecture halls, and subsequently, laboratories, with interactive presentation systems and laptops;
- participate in the organization and conduct of national seminars and conferences on the





digital transformation of education;

- participate in the organization and conduct of national and international conferences in the field of digital transformation of education;
- popularize own activities on social networks.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Trainers trained in digital skills and innovative teaching and learning methods have organized teacher training courses at every partner university in Kyrgyzstan. The courses were focused on a practical orientation and allowed lecturers / teachers to further use them in the educational process.

The main goal of the project is to adapt the education system in partner countries to the digital generation by introducing and effectively using innovative educational technologies and didactic models based on ICT in the educational process.

The consortium consists of 24 full partners - universities from 4 EU countries and 5 PS. The project will help transform partner universities into innovative universities and improve the quality of trained specialists required for digital transformation of industries (Industry 4.0).

The project recognizes the use of technology in transforming learning, developing collaboration solutions, enhancing the role of educators in an innovative technology-supported learning environment, enabling them to engage in professional learning that prepares them to skillfully apply research-based approaches to didactic learning.








2. What university do you represent?


161 answers, of which:






4. How well do you rate the quality?

capacity. For a year or two this is a short period Decades will be spent on transformation


